CHECKLIST: WHAT MUST BE INCLUDED IN YOUR RULES

Schedule 2 of the Industrial and Provident Societies Act 1908 (the Act) specifies what must be included in a society's rules.

- 1 Object, name, and place of office of the society.
- 2 Terms of admission of the members, including any society or company investing funds in the society under the provisions of paragraphs (c) or (d) of section 10 of the Act.
- 3 Mode of holding meetings, and right of voting and of making, altering, and rescinding rules.
- The appointment and removal of a committee of management, by whatever name, a secretary and managers or other officers, and their respective powers and remuneration.
- 5 Determination of the amount of interest in the shares of the society which any member other than a registered society may hold.
- Determination whether the shares or any number thereof shall be transferable; and, if it is determined that the shares or any number of them shall be transferable, provision for the form of transfer and registration of the shares, and for the consent of the committee thereto; and, if it is determined that the shares or any of them shall be withdrawable, provision for paying the members the balance due thereon on withdrawing from the society.
- 7 Provision for the audit of accounts.
- 8 Determination whether and how members may withdraw from the society, and provisions for the claims of executors or administrators of deceased members, or trustees of the property of bankrupt members and for the payment of nominees in the case herein mentioned.
- 9 Mode of application of profits.
- 10 Provision for the custody, use, and device of the seal of the society, which shall in all cases bear the registered name of the society.
- Determination whether and by what authority, and in what manner, any part of the capital may be invested.
